

Quilt is 62" x 88".

Fabric Cutting

Block Stripes

From EACH of the 6 fabrics cut $5-3^{3}$ %" x width of fabric strips Use the lines on the ruler to make sure the stripes on the fabric are straight when cutting.



Block Green Dot 4-3³/₈" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 20-33/8" x 73/4" rectangles.

Block Half Square Triangles

From EACH of the 5 fabrics cut 3-4" x width of fabric strips From the strips, cut 28-4" squares, cut in half once on the diagonal to make 56 half square triangles

Sashing

 $6-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips

Sashing Accent, Cornerstones & Binding

2 to 3-3¹/2" x width of fabric strips From the strips, cut 24-3¹/₂" squares $20-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips Sew 8 strips end to end for the binding.

Construction Use ¹/₄" seams and press in the direction of the arrows.

Cutting the rectangles from the stripe fabric strips:

(A) Cut on a line separating a red and a white stripe then measure 73/4" and cut. Repeat to cut 24-33/8" x 73/4" rectangles. Press the length of the rectangles in half to make a crease.



(B) Repeat to cut 24-33 "x 734" rectangles from each of the remaining 5 stripe fabrics. Press the length of the rectangles in half.

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2 To make one block: (A) Select 4 matching stripe 33/8" x 73/4" rectangles. Align the 45° line on the ruler with the crease and one end of the rectangle. Cut as shown. Repeat on the opposite end of the rectangle. Repeat to cut 4 elongated hexagons.



(B) Select 8 matching 4" half square triangles. Note: The half square triangles need not always match the color of the stripe. Add to 2 sides of the 4 units as shown. The half square triangles are oversized. Trim the block to measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Make 4. 51/2" x 51/2" unfinished



(C) Arrange and sew the 4 units in 2 rows; rotate the units to align the stripes as shown. Join the rows to make 1 block.



(D) Repeat steps 1 & 2 to make a total of 6 red, 6 pink, 6 yellow, 6 teal, and 6 green blocks.



- **3** To make 5 blocks from the green dot fabric: These blocks are simpler to make since there are no stripes to align.
 - (A) Press the 20-3%" x 7%"rectangles in half lengthwise.

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(B) Align the 45° line on the ruler with the crease of the rectangle and end of the rectangle. Cut as shown.Repeat on the opposite end of the rectangle. Repeat to cut 20 units.



(C) Select 8 matching 4" half square triangles. Add to the 2 sides of 4 units as shown. The half square triangles are oversized. Trim the block to measure 5¹/₂" square. Repeat to make 5 sets of 4 matching units.





(D) Arrange and sew 4 matching units in 2 rows as shown. Join the rows. Repeat to make 5 blocks.



Block 10½" x 10½" unfinished Make 5 total.

4 Sew 2-2½" x width of fabric sashing accent and 1-6½" x width of fabric sashing strips together as shown. Make 6 strip sets. Cut into 58-3½" wide units.



Arrange and sew 5 sashing units and 4 cornerstones in a row as shown. Press away from the cornerstones. Repeat to make 6 sashing rows.

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Fabric Requirements

Blocks

½ yard of 1 green dot print (32964 20)
% yard EACH of 5 stripe prints (32965 16, 32965 17, 32965 18, 32965 19, 32965 20)

Block Half Square Triangles

¹⁄₂ yard EACH of 5 prints (32963 13, 32964 12, 32964 16, 32964 19, 32964 20)

Sashing: 11/4 yards (32963 15)

Sashing Accent, Cornerstones and Binding 17/8 yards (32964 23)

Backing: 5¹/₃ yards

Easy Square Jr. 6¹/₂" Square Ruler by EZ (882670142 EZ) or a ruler with a 45° angle

6 Arrange and sew the blocks and sashing units in 7 rows of 5 blocks and 4 sashing units as shown. Press toward the sashing units. Join these rows and the sashing rows, alternating the rows as shown.



7 Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!



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
